EXPECTATIONS OF FOSTER HOMES

1. You are responsible for all feed, which includes grain, hay, and vitamins.
2. You must have a shelter; at least 3-sided, for the horse.
3. The horse must be on a feeding program to gain weight.
4. If the horse does not gain or it losses weight, you must notify a board member immediately.
5. You are responsible to have the horse's feet corrected or maintained by a farrier.
6. If the horse comes to you with an injury that needs care, you are responsible for treating the injury, which includes having a veterinarian treat it. If it does not heal or gets worse you must notify a board member immediately.
7. If the horse gets injured, you must notify a board member immediately.
8. If for any reason you cannot maintain the horse in the above listed ways, you must notify a board member right away and the horse will be picked up.
9. You are not allowed to make any inflictions on the horse that are permanent or life threatening without board approval.

Our goal is to help as many horses as we can. Fostering horses helps us free up space at our facilities and increases the overall number of horses that we can help. All foster horses are up for adoption, and with your help we can find permanent loving homes for these amazing horses.
