Working with Linn County Mental Health, LCAR currently offers two programs: developmentally disabled and Post Traumatic Stress Disorder. One of our goals is to expand the programs to include addiction, cancer, veterans, other illnesses, and social disabilities. Our programs are the last 2 Saturday of each month (except Dec.) from 1 pm to 3 pm. We invite anyone in need to come join us. The programs are very calm and you can interact at your own pace.
