Sunday 9:00 am - 6:00 pm

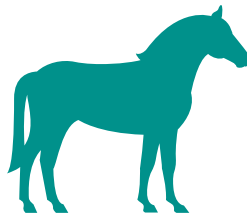
Volunteer Appreciation

her time with us. She's come so far that we are even able to
use her in our Healing Hearts with Horses program.
