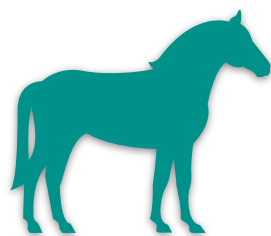
LCAR & BottleDrop
